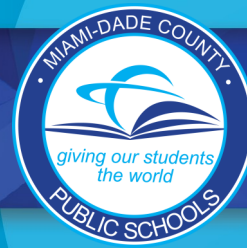
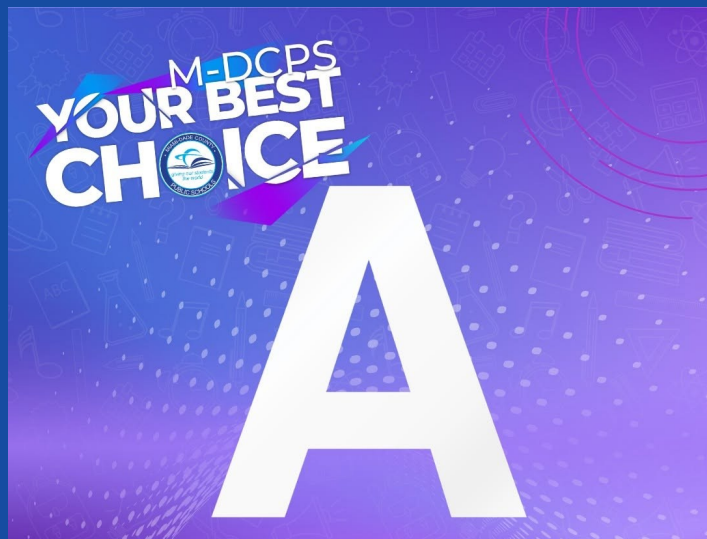

The School Board of Miami-Dade County has been awarded the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting by the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) for its Annual Comprehensive Financial Report for the fiscal year that ended June 30, 2025. Springing Forward

Results for the Spring 2026 administration of statewide assessments are back! Across all grade levels and subject areas, M-DCPS students outperformed the state by achieving higher percentages of students scoring on or above grade level in the FAST ELA Reading and Mathematics assessments, the B.E.S.T. Algebra 1 and Geometry EOC exams, and the Civics and U.S. History EOC exams, while also demonstrating strong progress with improvements across all science assessments from Spring 2025 to Spring 2026.



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
